Solve the problems.

- 1 8 blocks in all. 6 are red.  
Some are blue.  
How many are blue?

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$$8 - \underline{\quad} = 6$$

- 2 5 children play. 3 more children come.  
How many children in all?

1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10
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$$\underline{\quad} = 5 + 3$$

3  $7 - 2 = \underline{\quad}$

4  $6 + 3 = \underline{\quad}$

5  $\underline{\quad} = 9 - 2$

6  $6 + 1 = \underline{\quad}$

- 7 6 birds and 3 ants. How many more birds are there than ants?

Then write a number sentence.

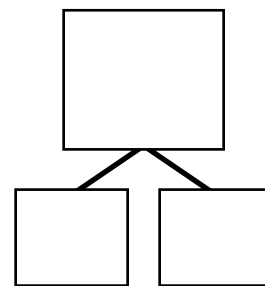
